Dress Code

Participants in The Canaccord Capital Big Brothers Golf Open should at all times dress in a manner appropriate for Shaughnessy Golf and Country Club. The Board of Directors asks that all members arrive at the club properly dressed.

The staff have been instructed by the Board of Directors to bring rules violations to attention immediately. The staff have been instructed to deny services to those persons who do not take corrective action to address the violation in question. All such violations will be reported to the General Manager. We ask you to make every effort to maintain the Club's tradition of proper attire.

General:

- Participants are expected to wear tidy and appropriate attire for the various club areas being used (course, courts, fitness, clubhouse, etc.).
- Denim or denim like material is not acceptable in any area of club property.
- Bare midriffs are not acceptable.
- Caps and clothing with commercial logos not related to golf or tennis are not allowed.
- Staff are instructed to enforce these rules and are empowered to refuse access to the course, courts or clubhouse.

On the Golf Course:

WOMEN – tailored slacks, capri pants, plus fours, golf skirts and Bermuda shorts or skorts no shorter than five (5) inches above the knee, are acceptable. Halter-styled tops, exercise pants, cargo (shorts or pants with patch pockets on the exterior) and "short shorts" are unacceptable. Shirts must have either a collar or sleeves and, with the exception of designer shirts, must be tucked in. Golf sandals are acceptable and may be worn with or without socks. Soft spikes are required while summer rules are in effect. Headwear must be worn in a forward position.

MEN – Full length slacks, plus fours with stockings and Bermuda-style shorts, no shorter than 3" above the knee are acceptable. Leisure suit, warm-up, cargo (shorts or pants with patch pockets on the exterior), capri or sweat-type pants are unacceptable. Golf shirts will have sleeves and collars, including turtlenecks or mock necks with a 1½" collar band and must be worn tucked inside the trousers. Golf sandals are acceptable and may be worn with or without socks. When Bermuda shorts are worn, socks shall be either knee-length with a turned down cuff or no higher than 3" above the shoe line. Socks may not be folded over, rolled down, saggy or colour banded. Short socks should be solid colour. Soft spikes are required while summer rules are in effect. Headwear must be worn in a forward position.

Lower Floor of Clubhouse:

Attire worn on the golf course, fitness centre or tennis courts is acceptable.

Upper Floor of Clubhouse:

All members and guests are expected to be neatly dressed in clean, appropriate attire. Gentlemen must remove sports headgear on the upper level of the clubhouse. Gentlemen must wear socks with all footwear except rubber-soled, moccasin-style, leather deck shoes, such as Topsiders or sandals. Soft spikes are permitted. Fitness attire is not acceptable on upper floor of clubhouse. Warm-up pants and top are required at all times in these areas.

On the Patios:

Headgear may be left on. All patios are gender neutral.
